SPANISH SPEAKERS

- Eligible to take the Police Officer Spanish Speaking Exam
 - Exam is in English same exam as Police
 Officer Exam
 - NO additional fee for exam
 - Separate eligible list
 - Proficiency in speaking Spanish only
 - Reading and writing comprehension in Spanish is NOT required
 - Upon being called Spanish speaking proficiency will be tested

Veterans

- 5 points for Veterans
- 10 points for disabled Veterans
- Civil service fee for Veterans residing in Suffolk County is waived
- 30 paid leave days per year to attend drills in the Reserve or National Guard
- Eligible to take a make-up exam if unavailable on June 17th, 2023 due to active military duty
- Military service buy back up to 3 years of credit towards retirement

- Pension plan. Members are eligible for retirement after twenty (20) years of service at 50% of three (3) year final average salary. Vested retirement plan after five (5) years.

• On top pay – you can expect to get paid approx. \$200,000(!!!) a year

• Upon retirement – you can expect your pension to be around \$100,000 a year for the REST OF YOUR LIFE (after only 20 years of service! *Or as low as 17 years with military buybacks!)
